- Giraffe

Allocation

The number of sets needed per centre / school should be calculated as two set per classroom. Keep in mind that learners will be eager to use them as well, not just the teacher.

General Comment

These hand puppets can be used during

- Free-play or classroom activities guided by the educator. It is excellent for use during the theme of Wild Animals.
- It is very useful to use as a story aid during storytelling.
- The hand puppets encourage speaking and communication.

Classroom lesson

Class	Learning Objective	Suggested Activity
1 yrs.	Touching textures. Sensory stimulation.	Use during story time. Please allow children to touch and feel the hand puppets. Do not use if children are scared of the puppets, in such case introduce very gradually.
2 yrs.	Teaching about animals. Sensory stimulation.	Allow the children to play with the hand puppets. They are fully washable. Let them choose which ones they want to play with. Assist with putting them on their hands. Borrow some sets from the other classes so that there will be enough for all in the class to choose from. Allow them to make the sounds associated with the puppet (roar like a lion)
3 yrs.	Teaching the children how to dress and undress by themselves. Making children aware of the wild animals.	Allow the children to put the hand puppets on. Let them choose which ones they want to wear. Borrow some sets from the other classes so that there will be enough for all in the class. Allow them to make the sounds associated with the
