Classroom lesson

Class	Learning Objective	Suggested Activity
1 yrs.	No allocation	
2 yrs.	Teaching about animals	Allow the children to put the clothes on and take them off. Let them choose which ones they want to wear. Assist with the dressing. This age group cannot dress by themselves. Borrow some sets from the other classes so that there will be enough for all in the class to choose from. Allow them to make the sounds associated with the costume (roar like a lion)
3 yrs.	Teaching the children how to dress and undress by themselves. Making children aware of different fantasy characters and animals	Allow the children to put the clothes on and take them off. Let them choose which ones they want to wear. Assist with the dressing where needed. Borrow some sets from the other classes so that there will be enough

for all in the class to choose from.

Allow them to make the sounds associated with the costume (roar like a lion)

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
